Registration for 2018-2019 School Year

Welcome!

We're looking forward to teaching your little one. Here's what to bring to get him or her registered on Feb. 28:

- **Birth Certificate** - If you do not have a birth certificate prior to the time your child begins school, you may call (314) 615-1720 (county) or (314) 613-3016 (city) to request a birth certificate.
- **Proof of Residency** -
 - 1) Mortgage statement dated within the last 30 days, 2017 paid real estate tax receipt and/or dated signed lease.
 - and
 - 2) Two monthly utility bills, dated within the last 30 days; if you reside with someone else, please contact Student Services office at (314) 213-8090 regarding residency verification forms. For more details, go online at www.psd3.org/enrollment.
- **Immunization Record** - Missouri law requires immunization of school children against polio, diphtheria, rubella, measles, mumps, and other illnesses. Immunizations are available through the St. Louis County Health Department (www.stlouisco.com/Healthandwellness) or your child's doctor. All students must meet immunization requirements before they may attend school.

Who Enrolls on Feb. 28

All children expecting to attend kindergarten in the 2018-2019 school year. Kindergarten students must be 5 years old on or before July 31, 2018 to enroll.

NOTE: *Early childhood students entering kindergarten still need to be registered.*



Where to Register

In the office of the elementary school serving the area where your home is located. Families are encouraged to bring their incoming kindergartner to registration. If you are unsure which school your child will attend, go online at www.psd3.org/map and click on "Find My School" under Attendance Areas. You can insert your child's grade (kindergarten) and your address to find your neighborhood school.

For a free kindergarten screening, go online to ec.psd3.org and click on "Sign up for a Screening."

Classes for the 2018-2019 school year begin Aug. 16, 2018.

Remington

Enrollment for Remington Traditional School, a K-8 school in Pattonville, is a lottery-based system. Parents interested in the lottery drawing **should enroll in their home school first** and then turn in an application for the lottery after March 1. Applications are available Feb. 1 in Remington's school office or online at remington.psd3.org. They are due back to Remington by March 16, 2018. The lottery will take place on April 3, 2018.
